

ORDINANCE NO. 17-18

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE 2018 REPLACEMENT PAGES
TO THE PORT CLINTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Constitution requires that Ohio municipal ordinances comply with State law if they are an exercise of the Municipality's police powers;

WHEREAS, an updated Traffic and General Offenses Code as contained in the current replacement pages has been prepared for the Municipality;

WHEREAS, certain other provisions within the Codified Ordinances should be amended to conform with current State law; and

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed by Council which should be included in the Codified Ordinances; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the ordinances of the City of Port Clinton, Ohio, of a general and permanent nature, as revised, recodified, rearranged and consolidated into component codes, titles, chapters and sections within the 2018 Replacement Pages to the Codified Ordinances are hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2: That the following sections and chapters are hereby added, amended or repealed as respectively indicated in order to comply with current State law.

Traffic Code

333.01 Driving Under the Influence. (Amended)
337.28 Use of Sunscreening, Nontransparent and Reflectorized
Materials.
(Amended)
351.07 Unattended Vehicles: Duties. (Amended)

General Offenses Code

513.09 Controlled Substance or Prescription Labels. (Amended)
529.07 Open Container Prohibited. (Amended)
529.08 Hours of Sale or Consumption. (Amended)
537.15 Temporary Protection Order. (Amended)

SECTION 3: That the complete text of the sections listed above are set forth in full in the 2018 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A. The listing above of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

SECTION 4: This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity for the earliest publication and distribution of 2018 Replacement Pages to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements, including conflict with general State law, and shall go into effect immediately.
