

ORDINANCE 22-17

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ISSUE
REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS AND ENTER INTO
AN AGREEMENT FOR DESIGN SERVICES AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

Whereas, the City of Port Clinton is pursuing the improvement of the riverfront area of the City with assistance of the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Alternative Program, and

Whereas, the City has been qualified by ODOT for the Project, and

Whereas, the City is required to issue requests for qualifications from engineering companies to perform Project Design Services to develop the scope of the Waterfront Walkway Project (the "Project"), and

Now, therefore, be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Safety and Service is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for requests for qualifications from engineering firms to perform Project Design Services and to rate such qualifications and enter into an agreement with one of the engineering firms to perform Project Design Engineering Services for the ODOT Transportation Alternative Program for the Project.

Section 2. The funds necessary to enter into the Project Design Services agreement are hereby appropriated from the Waterworks Park & Marina Development Fund, Account No. 101-0416-59100.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its Committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or Committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and for the further reason that his ordinance is required to be immediately effective so that the City may move forward timely with the design of the riverfront area improvements to meet the timelines of the ODOT so the construction may proceed as scheduled by ODOT, Wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
