AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF SAFETY AND SERVICE TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO CONTRACTS FOR THE REPAVING AND IMPROVEMENT OF FREMONT ROAD FROM THE WEST CORPORATION LINE EASTERLY TO THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF HARRISON STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, a portion of the public street known as Fremont Road is in need of improvement, repair and resurfacing, and

Whereas, the City has prepared plans and specifications for the Fremont Road improvements which include, among other improvements, milling and replacing pavement, City infrastructure replacement, providing for necessary drainage improvements and associated structures and appurtenances (the "Project"); and

Whereas, this Council finds and determines that the City should proceed with this Project at the earliest possible time.

Now, therefore, be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Port Clinton, Ottawa County, and State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Director of Safety and Service is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and enter into contracts for the repaying and improvement of Fremont Road, from its intersection with the west corporation line of the City easterly to the west right-of-way line of Harrison Street, all in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in his office.

Section 2. That the funds necessary to complete this Project are hereby appropriated from the Main Thoroughfare Fund.

Section 3. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its Committees concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or Committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to allow the City to advertise for bids for this project for construction at the earliest possible time and to take

advantage of lower costs of construction and so that the Project will be completed at the earliest possible time, Wherefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
